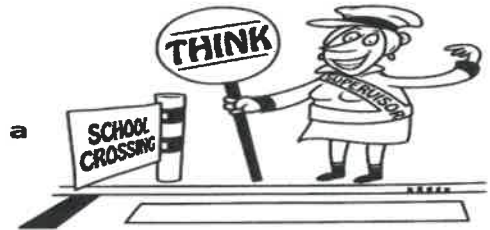
### *Principal's Report*
